What is the ClassMate Reader?

- A portable, versatile DAISY book playback device with visual interface:

 - read school books, novels, magazines, newspapers
 - reads text files, search for words within book, built-in dictionary
 - mark & review important passages with bookmarks and highlighting,
 - record questions and comments on passages with voice notes

- Free software to easily transfer books/files from the PC to the ClassMate Reader
- Status line for on-demand storage card info
- Use it to transfer text notes and voice note recording from ClassMate Reader to the PC
- Transfers PDF and Word Documents
